Code of Conduct

General Responsibilities for Players and Parents

Eagles Baseball Club expects all players and parents to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

1. Not knowingly discriminate against, abuse, harass, ridicule or embarrass anyone covered by this Code of Conduct.
2. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
3. Treat all people with respect, dignity and proper regard for their rights and obligations, and respect their privacy.
4. Act at all times in a fair and sporting manner to promote positive relationships within and between teams and organisations.
5. Refrain from intimate relationships with members over whom they have a supervisory role or position of authority.
6. Refrain from any form of victimisation towards others.
7. Conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on Eagles Baseball Club and does not bring the Club or its members into disrepute.
8. Not disclose confidential or privileged information concerning the Club, its teams or individuals to unauthorised persons.
9. Not promote, exchange or publish confidential, offensive, scandalous, unsubstantiated or derogatory information.
10. Refrain from using foul or abusive language, particularly in the presence of players, parents and the public.
11. Wear appropriate sport-related clothing while performing club duties.
12. Refrain from smoking, consuming alcohol or using illegal substances at training sessions or while actively participating in a game of baseball.

By registering as a player, or as the parent or guardian of a registered player, you agree to abide by this Code of Conduct and the spirit in which it has been written.
